



## Arts Education Grants for the 2012-2013 School Year

**Deadline: Thursday, March 15, 2012 at 2 PM**

These grants are designed to bring **artists of all disciplines** (including the visual arts, dance, music, theater, literature, video, and fiber arts) into the schools for an in-class residency that integrates the arts and non-arts subjects. We encourage artists, teachers, administrators, parents and nonprofit cultural organizations to collaborate on well-planned partnerships that are based on the New York State Learning Standards and include an extensive in-class residency.

Please note that in the past the Arts Education (AE) grants have had a matching requirement. However, **the cash match required from the school partner has been removed**. This means a school or arts organization may apply for 100% of their program's cost.
